# Who we are

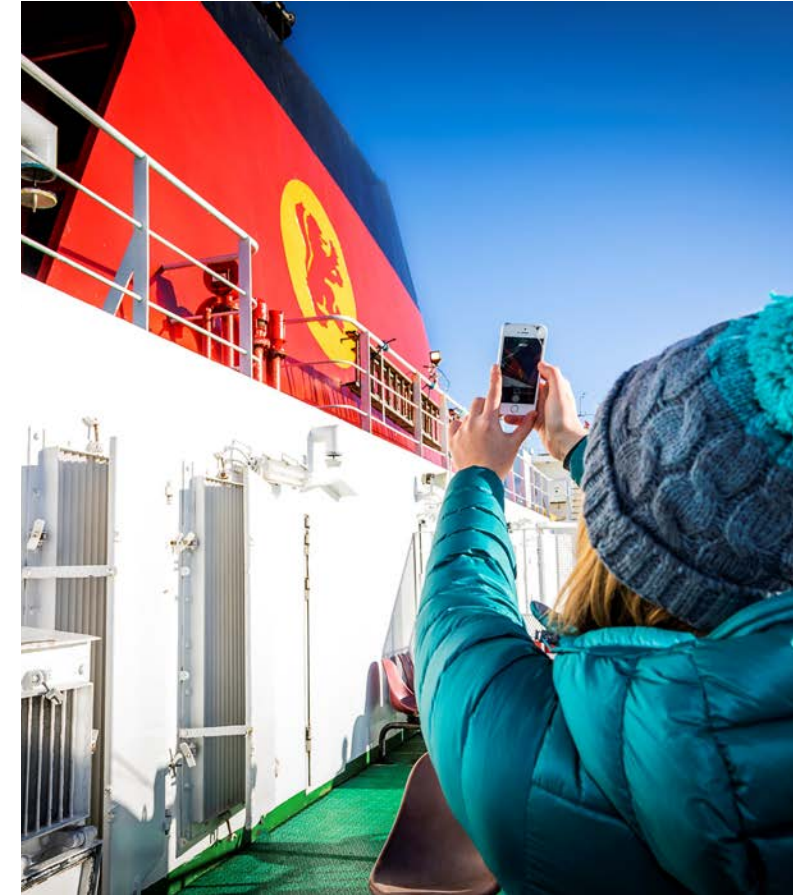
