TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. BOOKING:

- Please **pre-book** for both Groups and FITs/Small Groups. This helps us to manage the number of people in the Cathedral at any one time and guarantees your spaces
- Trade rates are available for FITs/Small Groups and Groups 10+ if you pre-book. Walk-ups and unbooked groups will be charged the full (public) rate per individual
- We operate an invoicing system for groups that visit regularly as a result we no longer accept vouchers. Please contact the bookings team if you wish to become an account customer.
- Numbers must be confirmed and paid for 48 hours before you arrive (unless you have made a prior arrangement with us). If we do not receive confirmation at that point, the tickets will go back on sale
- One complimentary ticket per group is available for an accompanying guide or group leader. Educational groups are permitted 1 complimentary leader ticket per 10 students. Students visiting as part of an educational group must be accompanied by an adult in all areas of the Cathedral.

 - ✓ Tour with own guide: the group's own tour leader/guide shows them the Cathedral

TOWER TOUR

For many people, the Tower Tour is the absolute highlight of their visit to Salisbury Cathedral. Wind your way up narrow spiral staircases climbing 332 steps in easy stages into our ancient roof spaces and to the foot of our iconic spire, 68 metres above ground level. Enjoy spectacular sights - an uninterrupted aerial view of the inside of the Cathedral, the inside of the spire supported by medieval wooden scaffolding and panoramic views of Salisbury and surrounding water meadows. Our experienced guides will tell you all about the construction of this architectural masterpiece.

4. WORKS YARD TOURS

Our expert guides will show you around our Stonemasonry Works Yard, one of only ten English Cathedral work yards in the country. Learn how 150-million-year-old blocks of Jurassic limestone weighing up to 5 tons are transformed into carved stone for the Cathedral. You'll visit the Drawing Office where the conservators and stone specialists carry out conservation planning. And you'll witness astounding hand-carving skills that have been practiced here since the 1200s.
