# DAY 1: PARIS Check in

From 17:00 onwards. Bags could be dropped from 16:00hours. There is a left luggage facility at Gare du Nord. Ship does not open before this time, as supplies are being loaded and other logistics taking place.

It might be possible to drop luggage on one of our other ships, which are moored at the same place; however, this information becomes available later on.

Gala evening and the "Paris by night" cruise (depending on water level), where you'll float through the beautifully illuminated city, particularly attractive when viewed from our vantage point on the Seine.

### **DAY 4: PARIS**

Enjoy breakfast before disembarking at 9:00 a.m. End of our services.
