Coach Friendly Status Bid for Christchurch

Plans are underway to achieve Coach Friendly Status for the Saxon town of Christchurch. The first steps saw the return of coach parking when it was secured with the instalment of three coach spaces at Two Riversmeet Leisure Centre last year. The aim is to align Christchurch with the accredited status, already achieved in neighbouring Bournemouth and Poole.

A preliminary audit of the town took place at a meeting on Tuesday (27 July), attended by John Burch of the Confederation of Passenger Transport. Works will now begin, following recommendations from Mr Burch, to facilitate the plans. A further inspection later on will determine the outcome.

COACH PARKING RESTRICTIONS/DROP OFF AND ROAD CLOSURES

If you are visiting Bournemouth during the Air Festival, please refer to the **Traffic Restrictions Map**.

Coach drop off points are available on Westover Road (BH1 2BU).

Coach parking: Queens Road coach and car park (BH2 6BE) will be available for coach parking on all four days of the festival. **Please note:** coach parking at Kings Park will not be available during the duration of the Air Festival and drop off site in the Layby at the back of Hot Rock Café, Pier Approach will not be available.

Please refer to the linked map above for details about our road closures. Coaches will not be allowed through these areas.

Red Arrows, Battle of Britain Memorial Flight (BBMF) and Typhoon all confirmed.

Bringing some much-needed entertainment to the BCP area the greatest free land, air and sea event is set to take place **Thursday 2**nd – **Sunday 5**th **September.**Bournemouth Air Festival will not only welcome the greatest RAF line up in five years but also some new and exciting attractions at sea and on the ground.

In the skies the Red Arrows, Typhoon and the BBMF will perform across all four days – the first time all three RAF display teams have been part of the festival line up since 2016!

Night Air flying takes place Thursday, Friday and Saturday evening with Unarmed Combat Displays and Sunset Beat Retreat Ceremony performed by The Band of Her Majesty's Royal Marines Collingwood in the Lower Gardens.
