Newport Transporter Bridge will open in 2024/25 as an innovative attraction experience with a new visitor centre, café and toilets, shop and exhibition space. It is one of the most complete surviving transporter bridges, and only one of 6 remaining in the world. It is also the inspiration for the interior design of the nearby 135 bedroomed Mercure Newport Hotel that opened in 2022.

The Museum of Land Speed has opened telling the story of Pendine and the land speed records by Sir Malcolm Campbell and John Parry Thomas. The interactive exhibition features motorbikes and other large objects including Babs – the ill-fated car that crashed, killing John Parry Thomas and was buried for around 70 years in the sands.
